






- Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge



Kaktovik, Alaska



- Northern shore of Alaska near the eastern border
- Inupiate population of about 300 native Americans
- Granted subsistence harvesting of 3 bowhead whales per year, plus walrus, seals, caribou, musk ox, and dall sheep
- Special relationship with the polar bears the largest land predator (actively hunt humans)










Denali Dall




Double Dipping
